

RESIDENTIAL SUBSTANCE ABUSE TREATMENT ADMISSIONS CHECKLIST

To be admitted to J-CAP's Residential Substance Abuse Treatment Program, you must bring the following with you:

1. At least two (2) items of identification (i.e. birth certificate with raised seal, Social Security card, passport, state Driver's License or ID, Baptismal Certificate, Military ID or Green Card)
2. Recent Tuberculosis test results or Chest X-RAY results (within 6 months of admission). If you don't have this documentation, arrangements will be made to have you tested.

Items that you SHOULD bring with you upon admittance to our residential substance abuse treatment program:

1. Ten (10) complete sets of clothing
2. Two (2) pairs of shoes
3. One (1) pair of sneakers
4. One (1) winter coat
5. Toiletries (soap, deodorant, toothpaste, non-alcoholic mouthwash)
6. Electric shaver

Items that are NOT allowed in our residential substance abuse treatment program:

1. Cigarettes - we are a smoke-free agency as required by the New York State Office of Alcoholism and Substance Abuse Services (OASAS)
2. Any form of jewelry (watches, prayer beads, bracelets, earrings, etc.)
3. Pictures/photos
4. Books or magazines
5. Colognes, perfumes or make-up
6. Money (except the amount of car fare required to get home in the event you are not admitted)
7. Cell phones, Walkman, iPods, radios, DVD Players, mp3 players, etc.
